<b>Cars</b>		<p>Russian customs charge import customs duties on personal motor vehicles, with the exception of motor vehicles belonging to foreign diplomats.</p> <p>In order to transport a motor vehicle across the Russian border, the importer must pay a deposit to Moscow customs in advance. The amount of the deposit depends on year of manufacturing and the engine volume</p>	<p>Cars may be imported into Russia. Check with your agent for conditions beforehand</p>

<p><b>Importing and exporting of Items of Cultural Value (ICV) into Moscow.</b></p>	<p><b>Examples of Items of Cultural Value are:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Antique furniture and ornaments,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Drawings or paintings,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Hand-made carpets,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Coin, stamp and other collections,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Samples of flora and fauna,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Figurines and icons,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Books (older than 100 years),</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Musical instruments (pianos, grand pianos, violins, cellos, contrabasses, etc.),</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Precious metals or items manufactured from precious metals,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Precious or semi-precious stones, and any items manufactured from them, sculptures and statues,</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Subjects of interest from various branches of science (mineralogy, anatomy and palaeontology).</b></li> </ul> <p><b>All items older than 50 years are also considered to be items of cultural value.</b></p> <p><b>Ryabinovaya customs terminal in Moscow has recently been substituted for Butovo and is not yet authorised to clear ICV. ICV cannot be customs cleared with household goods shipments. ICV will either have to be sent separately from the household goods shipment, or wait for authorisation for the customs terminal to clear ICV.</b></p> <p><b>ICV shipments bound for Moscow cannot be registered at customs for future export. One will have to apply for an export permit for the already imported ICV.</b></p>
